## Prior/Background Knowledge:

In previous units in KS1 pupils have:

- Discussed what God might be like
- Children have read the Creation Story from the Bible
- Children studied a unit about the Creation Story from the Bible in KS1
- Children have identified some similarities and differences in aspects of faith between Judaism, Islam and Christianity through various units of study in KS1
- Children know that The Bible, The Qur'an and The Torah are Holy Books.



What the children will learn about and background information and key texts they will use:

Children will:

- Explore creation stories from Judaism, Islam, Sikhism and Christianity.
- Compare and contrast the different stories.
- Consider how these stories have impacted on faiths in the past.
- Consider how they are relevant to life today.
- Express their ideas about how to look after the world around them.
- Explore how faith stories and scientific theories of evolution co-exist.

Key questions from the children:

**Genesis:** a book from the Old Testament of the **Bible** and from **Torah** that tell the creation story

**Guru Granth Sahib Ji:** Sikh creationism reference
