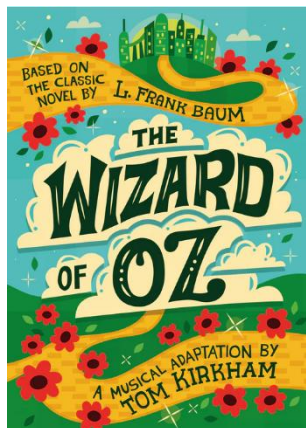


KS2 Sports Day:

This year, our **KS2 SPORTS DAY**, will be held at Westmoor Primary School as previously mentioned. This will take place on **Friday 27th June**. Each child in Key Stage 2 will bring home **2 free tickets** next week for the event. If you require more than this then please contact the school office. All parents and carers **must** be at the entrance to the Sports Hall by **1.30pm**. Due to safeguarding procedures, after this time I am afraid adults will not be allowed on site. This is to safeguard all the children at Westmoor and St John's. Westmoor children will be inside the school building working. We will be outside on the field or in the sports hall if the weather is bad. No alcohol or pets are allowed to be brought on to the school site. Please can parents remain within the designated parent and carers areas to enable the afternoon to run as smoothly as possible. The event will finish at 2.45pm. All children will be taken back to school and must be collected at the normal time or older children can walk home from St John's if this is the normal arrangement. No children will be allowed to leave from Westmoor again due to safeguarding.
