Dear Parents and Carers,

This week, it has been Anti-bullying week across the country. Thank you for supporting this by sending your child in odd socks on Tuesday to celebrate difference and get children to value the importance of accepting and respecting difference. Bullying is very rare at St John's, which Ofsted agreed with in our recent inspection. On the odd occasions when bullying has occurred, it has been dealt with efficiently and appropriately. However, children must realise that bullying can come in different forms and can happen at any point in their lives and in all walks of life. To help children we use the acronym 'STOP'. This means considering is it Several Times On Purpose and if it is happening, we need to Start Telling Other People. Please take some time to read our Antibullying Policy, which was written by our school council last year and previously circulated with all parents and carers.

Children in Years 3 and 5 this week have had road safety sessions, which have been really valuable and included the children going out on to the road to learn about crossing the roads and walking at the side of roads safely. Please remind children about how to use the roads safely when out and about.

Preparations have also begun in school preparing for our Christingle, Advent and Christmas celebrations. The children have enjoyed singing and learning new songs.

Traffic and Parking:

Once again, I am writing to you regarding the parking situation outside school. As you will be aware, it does get very congested outside our school at drop-off and pick-up times. Parking in restricted places, such as where the zig zag lines are, poses a risk for all children including your own! It is not appropriate to be turning around in the road, mounting pavements or ignoring staff requests not to park in restricted areas. We just want everyone to be safe! Traffic wardens have made spontaneous visits and will be returning. In the meantime, they have asked us to report registrations of people who are illegally parking outside school on a regular basis, which we will be doing. Please do your bit by setting off that little bit earlier, parking further away or better still walking to school. Thank you.



Severe Weather Arrangements:

As we enter the winter season, it is essential that all children come dressed appropriately to school and with a good winter coat and suitable footwear. This includes considering sending your child with a hat and gloves.
