Toys:

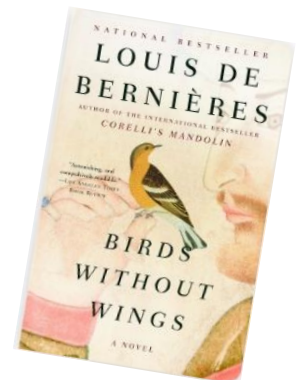
A reminder that no toys should be brought into school. Please make sure your child does not bring them in as it can cause problems in school.
