School Meals:

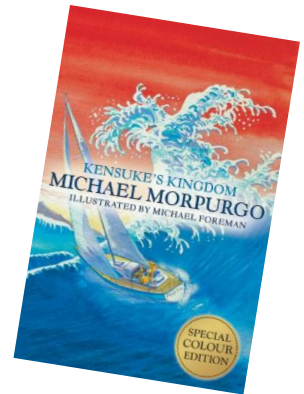
Please note that from September 2025, Kirklees will be increasing the cost of school meals to £2.85. We are just making you aware of this up-and-coming increase.
