Year 1: Mechanisms How do you make a picture move?



Core content:

Investigate how sliders work. Design and make a card slider product.

Technical vocabulary:

Slider — a rigid bar which moves backwards and forwards along a straight line.



Slot — a narrow cut which a slider can pass through.



Bridge — rectangles cut from rigid material and stuck to the surface which the slider passes under.



Push — a force to move something away from you.



Pull — a force to move something closer to you. (



Rigid — stiff and difficult to move or bend
