Prior/Background Knowledge:

This Unit of Work consolidates the learning that has occurred during the year. All the learning is focused around revisiting chosen nursery rhymes and/or songs, a context for the History of Music and the very beginnings of the Language of Music.



Key vocab and definitions:

- **pulse:** the heartbeat or steady beat of a song or piece of music.
- **rhythm:** when long sounds and short sounds are put together.
- **pitch:** range of high and low sounds.

Key questions from the children:

Blank green area for recording key questions from the children.

What the children will learn about and background information and key texts they will use:

Listen out for instruments they can hear within musical extracts.

Begin to **compose** sections of a familiar song by dragging notes on the computer.

Further explore the theory of music: **pulse, rhythm, pitch.**

Revisit previous learnt songs and perform.
