

12 countries, Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Columbia, Bolivia...
Brazil - largest country in South America Brasília - capital city
Argentina Buenos Aires- capital city

Europe

6th largest continent (6/7)
Northern hemisphere
44 countries, UK, France, Spain, Germany, Italy, Poland, Russia,
Russia - largest country in Europe Moscow - capital city
France Paris - capital city
