Core content:

Create 3D forms using a variety of techniques. Consider use of colour, pattern and texture. Combine pieces to form 3D structures.

Technical vocabulary:

Translucent – material which allows light to pass through but is not completely clear.



Glassblowing – a glass forming technique that involves inflating molten glass into a bubble with the aid of a blowpipe.



Starch – a white substance from potatoes and grains, used to make cloth stiff.



Asymmetric balance – when there are different visual images on either side of a design, but the image is still balanced.



Amorphous – having no definite shape, form or structure.



Biomorphic – artistic designs based on naturally occurring patterns or shapes.
